The volunteers spent a few hours moving sod, spreading compost, sand, and mulch. The payoff is gratitude in giving and fulfilling our

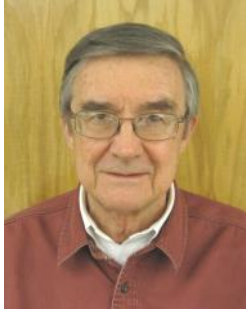
agreement to St. James. I strongly urge you to volunteer when asked. As the famous line goes:

## Secretary's Report Board Meeting – June 5, 2017

Peter D'Attomo called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mike Kalscheur, Rich Rossio, Laura Rossio, Bruce Kinney, Lee Nye, Bert LeLoup, Whit Anderson, Will Richards, Eleanore Richards, Tony Evansky, Jack Pine, and Jerry Johnson. Reminder: Any club member is invited to attend board meetings.

The May minutes and treasurer's report were approved.

### Committee Reports

**Membership** – There were no new members added in May so the membership remains at 156. A question was raised about the date for reduced dues and how that would tie into the seller's fee at the Auction. After some discussion Jerry provided a clarification saying that the dues are \$25 through June 30. On July 1 they drop to one-half rounded to \$13. The individual must be on the roster as of June 30. Individuals that join on July 1 or later need to pay the auction seller's fee. The ten percent seller's fee applies to all non-members.

**Prizes** – Bruce reported he has acquired door prizes for meetings through September.

**Newsletter** – The deadline for submitting material to Bert is Saturday June 10. It was noted that Rockler has opened two new stores in our area. This raised the question of whether they should receive a copy of the newsletter. It was affirmed that any business that offers the club members a discount should receive a copy and they have a choice of email or "snail" mail. (Reference: May, 2015 board minutes.)

**Activities** – Rich has plans for a Jack Harkins shop tour on June 17 from 9:00 to noon... He also is arranging a rabbit plane making workshop to be led by Chris Yonkers – tentative date July 22.

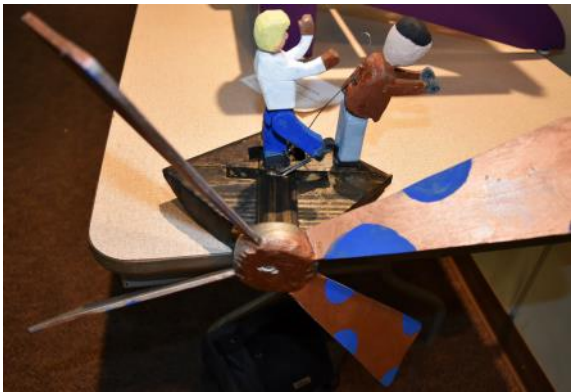

## June Toy...Copy & print it out for your shop

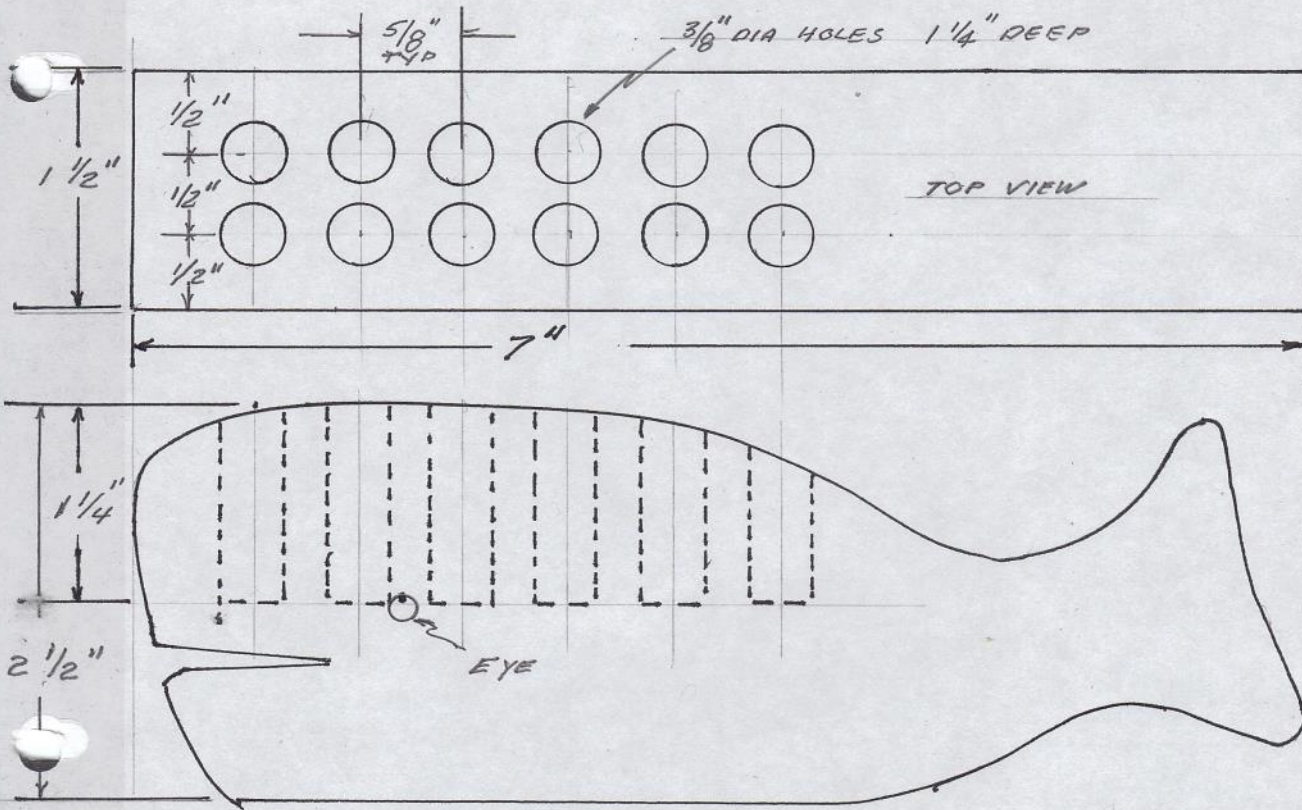
### Whale Crayon Holder Operation Sheet

Material -2" 1/2" x 7" 1/4" x 1" 1/2" board  
 Poplar or other close grained wood.

Equipment Required: -Band saw,drill press, Router.

#### Operations:

1. Cut wood blank to size noted above
2. Using a square locate and mark hole spacing on the top of the workpiece. (see plan below,)
3. Locate and draw lines <sup>1/2"</sup> from both edges on top of the workpiece The intersecting lines are the center points where 3/8" holes will be drilled. Mark these points with an awl. (workpiece is still a square block).
4. Drill 3/8" holes 1 1/4" deep, (12 holes).
5. Using whale template trace outline of whale on the workpiece. Be sure holes are toward the front. (mouth). Mark eye and mouth locations.
6. Cut whale profile and mouth. Drill eye location. Both sides.
7. Sand all sharp edges or route with 1/8" router bit.
