

The DuPage Woodworkers Club encourages members to donate time and skills every year to [make toys](#) to give to charities for distribution to needy children. In 2017 club members made and donated over 1,500 wood toys. As part of that effort the club is creating a list of finishes which are approved for use on toys. We are asking your company to contribute to this volunteer effort by sending us confirmation that your finishes listed on the next page meet the chemical requirements of the CPSC for toys. Specifically the finishes must meet the requirements of ASTM F963 for metals and CPSC rules for phthalates as outlined in the table below in order for us to use the finish on a toy.
